CLUB COMPETITION INFORMATION

1. General Conditions of Play

- The Rules of Golf as laid down from time to time by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews shall apply, except insofar as they are modified from time to time by LOCAL RULES.
- All members shall abide by the club By-Laws (available from the club upon request).
- All competitions are under the control of the Club Captain, relevant Vice Captain or a member of the relevant Match Committee, who reserve the right to change or alter any date or cancel or vary any competition.
- The Men's Committee is responsible for Friday, Saturday Men's and Sunday Competitions. The Women's Committee is responsible for Wednesday and Saturday Women's Competitions.
- On days when competitions arranged by the Match Committees are in progress, any member or visitor taking part can play only when directed by the starter or relevant Match Committee.
- Any protest in connection with a competition should be made in WRITING to the Club Captain, relevant Vice-Captain or a member of the relevant Match Committee immediately on the completion of the round, NOT DURING A ROUND. Paper and pens are available from the match committee room. Please detail the event including; the complaint itself, rule number, the date & time, location of incident, your name, name(s) of those involved, and any witness' details – hand it to a Bar person and advise it is to go to the first Match Committee Members they see, it's OK to mention to a Match Committee member that there is a report waiting for them at the bar, and please give them time to investigate and respond to it.

2. Booking Sheets, Open Days and Invitation Days

- Please use the internet booking sheet for all Competitions or call the Pro Shop to book.
- Players should book their names on the time sheet via the Club's kiosk/booking website to ensure a place in block time.
- To facilitate groupings for the Saturday Competition, in the event of a 2-ball event being held in-conjunction (men's or women's), wherever possible consideration should be given to avoid 3-1 mixed playing groups.

- All Fridays and Sundays are open (Medley) events. Men's & women's Saturday events are also open however, whilst visitors can play and win the 'Competitions of the Day', they cannot win any Monthly Medals or other Board/Trophy events. Saturday tee times will be subject to a draw at the Club for members on the Friday night two weeks prior to the event. Booking via the internet timesheet for the week commencing in two weeks' time will be available from 8am on Saturday. Members are able to book visitors at the Friday night draw, and visitors may book via the pro shop or bar from 8am the following morning.
- A number of Open Days are available for women, usually the last Wednesday of the month.
- Any alterations, additions to, or deletions of bookings to the computer/booking sheet, must be approved by the player whose booking is being altered, any incidents without that player's permission may result in the offender's time sheet rights being suspended.

3. Friday & Sunday Open (Medley) Competitions

 Open Medley Competitions are run each Friday & Sunday. The structure of the competitions will be determined by the Men's Match Committee and is subject to change. Please use the booking sheet for the Friday Competition.

4. Medley Events Competition

Medley identifies competitions where men and women play together.
 Groups can consist of all men, all women or any combination of men and women.

5. Block and Competition Times

Saturday: Winter 7.00am until 11.30am

Summer 6.00am until 10.30am

Sunday: 9.00am until 10.30am

(Earlier Sunday tee times via the Pro-shop)

Wednesday: 8.00am until 10.00am Friday: First Light until 1.00pm

Weekday 9 Hole: First Light until Pro Shop Close

6. Tee Times

- Players are to check in at the pro shop & check handicaps TEN
 minutes before they tee off and be ready to tee off five minutes before
 their scheduled time or when called to do so by the starter.
- Prompt notice must be given to the starter when bookings cannot be kept in time. Members should note that bad weather may not be a sufficient reason for repeated or late cancellations.

7. Playing Conditions and Local Rules

- Conditions of play will be displayed on the notice board outside the pro shop. It is the player's responsibility to be aware of the conditions as they can vary from day to day.
- Permanent Local Rules are printed on the Score Cards, as well as in the MiScore app. Additions to Permanent Rules and current Temporary Local Rules will be posted on the Notice Board at the Pro Shop.

8. Visiting Players

- Visiting players must be able to provide evidence of their handicap and ensure that their name, Club and Golflink number are clearly shown on their scorecard, if relevant.
- Visitors are to ensure their scores are entered in the computer after the game and card (if using one) placed in the correct box. Visitors must have the Pro-shop enter their contact details into the booking system and consent to the Club using those details if it needs to contact them.

9. Eligibility for Major Events

- No member shall be eligible to play in any major event of the golf club
 if they have not returned THREE (3) Barnwell Park Member's Singles
 Competition Cards <u>after joining the club</u> in the twelve months prior to
 the event. The major events of the club are the Scratch Club
 Championships (A, B, C Grades, Junior and Senior), Match Play
 Championships (A, B, C Grades and Junior), Foursomes
 Championship (Scratch) and Mixed Foursomes Championship
 (Scratch).
- Women members must have at least THREE live cards at January 1 each year to retain a GA handicap.

10. Junior Participation in Club Event

- The maximum number of juniors allowed to participate in any one group in an "open" (adult) club event is THREE. <u>An adult Member</u> <u>must accompany them</u> unless they have the permission of the Club Captain.
- For a stand-alone junior competition, there must be a minimum of FOUR participants.

11. Eligibility of Professionals

 Professional golfers cannot win or qualify for any of the major events of the club.

12. Completed Cards / MiScore App

- Players must return their score within 15 minutes of completing their round. Players must enter their own scores into the computer (when available) if using a card.
- Only a fellow competitor is eligible to be a marker during Major Events, their qualifying rounds and Monthly Medal rounds.
 The fellow competitor must be a competitor in the SAME competition as the player. (Penalty for breach is disqualification).

13. Handicaps

- Handicaps are revised in accordance with the Rules of Golf and are subject to change at any time. Members should return scores for all rounds played, ensuring their full name and Golflink number are legible (if using a card). The current grades are listed below.
 - Men: Daily Handicaps (A + 12) (B 13 19) (C 20 54).
 - Women's Divisions: Club Events and Club Championships Daily Handicaps (i 0 – 23) (ii 24 – 31) (iii 32 – 54). GNSW Medals GA Handicaps (i 0 – 20) (ii 20.1 – 29) (iii 29.1 – 54).

14. Deciding Ties

- Ties in certain events will be decided whenever possible by replay. If the Committee considers this to be not possible or is otherwise specified in the event's Conditions of Play, the following count back method shall apply:
- For 18 hole stroke events, the best score on the last 9 holes (1/2

handicap). If there is still a tie, the best score on the last 6 holes (1/3 handicap). If there is still a tie, the best score on the last 3 holes (1/6 handicap). If a tie still exists, a hole by hole count back from the 18th hole shall take place. For events other than stroke, the procedure as mentioned shall apply without handicap deduction.

 For events of greater than 18 holes, the above procedure shall apply for the last 18 holes of the event.

15. Priority on the Course

- Pairs, threesomes and foursomes shall have precedence over and be entitled to pass any other kind of match. A single player has no standing and should give way to a match of any kind. Any match playing for a whole round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round.
- To assist in the smooth and free flow of competitions, players are asked to give preference to a player from another fairway, especially when FOUR players are to hit off.

16. Eliminating Slow Play

- Play 'Ready Golf' unless the event is match play.
- Let the group behind through at your earliest convenience, do not wait to be asked.
- In all Par or Stableford events, pick up when a score is no longer possible.
- Directly it is your turn to play, do so at once. Practice swings should be limited by discretion.
- Study your line on the putting green while others are putting. You do
 not have to move about to do this, but you have to get to the position of
 your ball before the first player putts. The player nearest the hole
 should attend the flag then pass it onto the first player to hole out.
- When the result of a hole has been determined, players should immediately leave the green.
- Record scores on the card while waiting to tee off at the next hole.
- Leave buggies adjacent to the approach to the next tee.
- Players searching for a ball should immediately call the following players through, and in accordance with the rules have 3 minutes to search.
- Your position in the field is behind the group in front, NOT ahead of the group behind.

17. Compulsory Stop

When the 9th hole has been completed after the club opening times, a
compulsory short stop is in effect for all players. Players are to move
on when the following group enters the clubhouse. Players must not
allow the preceding group to get more than the required distance
ahead. Food and drinks purchased should be appropriate to the
shortness of the stop.

18. Calling On

Players who "call on" do so at their own risk. If the next tee is free, it is
quicker for the field for you to put out rather than call up.

19. Care of the Course

 It is the responsibility of all players to fill in divots, repair lob marks on greens and smooth out bunkers.

Eligibility for Representative Events

 For players to be eligible to represent Barnwell Park in any Pennant Competition they must have submitted FIVE (5) Barnwell Park Member's Singles Competition Cards in the previous twelve months prior to the competition.

MEN

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP - Scratch & Handicap

To be played over 72 holes (4 rounds) from Championship Plates in three grades (A, B, C) with a Junior Championship (Under 18 years) and Senior Championship (over 50) in conjunction.

The lowest aggregate scratch score in each grade will be awarded with the championship for that grade. The lowest overall score will determine the Club Champion. Trophies will also be awarded to the runners up in A, B and C Grade Scratch Events.

There will also be a nett event in conjunction in A, B and C Grades and the Senior division. Player's handicaps from round one of the championship will be used for the duration of the championship. All ties in the scratch division will be decided by sudden death starting from the 1st hole until a result is obtained. Ties in the nett event will be resolved by a count back as determined by the system.

The First Round will be scheduled as close to the start of October as possible, the Second and Third Rounds will be the Captain's Trophy.

MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

A minimum of 8 players attempting to qualify in each grade is required to constitute the event. Best 8 scratch scores in each division (A, B, C) and Junior in conjunction after two qualifying rounds are eligible to participate. Any ties in qualifying will be decided by count back. All ties in the competition, including the finals, will be decided by sudden death until a result is obtained. The event is knockout from the Championship Plates, off scratch, over 18 holes.

FOURSOMES - Scratch & Handicap

This is a 36 hole scratch event played over 2 weeks, and an 18 hole handicap event over one-week. A minimum of 8 pairs attempting to qualify is required to constitute the event. The top 8 pairs (& ties) from week 1 of the scratch event qualify for week

Players teeing off from odd holes in round 1 must tee off from even holes in round 2 and vice versa. The best scratch score over two rounds will determine the club champions. All ties in the scratch division will be decided by sudden death starting from the 1st hole until a result is obtained. Ties in the nett event to be resolved by a count back as determined by the system.

COCK O' THE WALK

A minimum of 8 pairs attempting to qualify is required to constitute the event. Best 8 pairs to qualify after one round of 4 Ball Best Ball Stableford off handicap. Qualifiers are to play off their current handicap on any day of play. Any ties in qualifying will be decided by count back. All ties in the competition will be decided by sudden death until a result is obtained. The event is knockout from Championship Plates, off handicap over 18 holes.

MEDAL ROUNDS

Medal rounds are held once a month (usually the first Saturday). The lowest score off handicap over 18 holes is to be deemed the winner of the medal. All ties are to be determined by count back on day.

MEDAL OF MEDALS

Only the winners of monthly medals from November to October each year are eligible. The player plays off his current handicap in the Medal of Medals.

ALL TIES ARE TO BE PLAYED OFF IN THE FOLLOWING MEDAL ROUND (OFF HANDICAPS USED FOR THE DECEMBER MEDAL ROUND).

MIXED FOURSOMES - Scratch & Handicap

A minimum of 8 pairs is required to constitute the event. Played over 36 holes (2 rounds) <u>from the championship plates</u> with a handicap event in conjunction. Men tee off from odd holes in round 1. Women tee off from the odd holes in round 2. The best scratch score over two rounds will determine the club champions.

All ties in the scratch division will be decided by sudden death starting from the 1st hole until a result is obtained. Any ties in the nett event will be resolved by a count back as determined by the system.

MIXED MATCHPLAY

A minimum of 8 pairs attempting to qualify is required to constitute the event. Best 8 pairs to qualify after one round of 4 Ball Best Ball Stableford off handicap. Any ties in qualifying will be decided by count back. All ties in the competition will be decided by sudden death until a result is obtained. The event is knockout off 3/4 current handicaps over 18 holes from the championship plates.

WOMEN

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP - Scratch & Handicap

Championships to be played over 72 holes from the markers near plates in four (4) divisions. The winners for each division will be calculated from the best of three rounds, the lowest aggregate scratch score in each division will be awarded with the Championship for that division. The lowest overall score will determine the Club Champion. In the event of a tie, for both scratch and nett, there will be a playoff over 18 holes. If still tied, a sudden death playoff will take place over holes 1, 3 and 4. Player's handicaps from round one of the Championship will be used for the duration of the championship. Women can compete in both Saturday & Wednesday Rounds, however only Saturday winner will be named Club Champion.

The **Senior Women's Club Champion**, scratch and nett, will be determined concurrently with the Club Championship, using the same scratch and nett scores applicable for the Club Championship. To be eligible, a player must be aged 50 or over at the start of the first round. There will be only one scratch and one nett prize, determined across all handicaps. Ties will be decided by the same method as for the championships.

The winner of the Club Championship scratch event may not also win the Senior Club Championship scratch event. If the lowest scratch score in the Club Championship is attained by a senior, the Senior Women's Club Championship will be awarded to the senior player with the next best scratch score.

FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP - Scratch & Handicap

To be played over 36 holes (2 rounds) from the championship plates with a handicap event in conjunction. Players teeing off from odd holes in round 1 must tee from even holes in round 2 and vice versa. The best scratch score over two rounds will determine the club champions. In the event of a tie, a play-off will be held over 3 holes - 1, 3 & 4. Whoever teed off at the 1st hole in the first round will tee off at the first hole in the play-off, the other player tees off at the 3rd hole and the two players continue to tee off alternately from then on (ie. the 4th hole and any subsequent sudden death holes.) The winner of the play-off is the pair with the lowest total score for the three holes. If scores are still tied, a sudden death playoff will occur over holes 8 and 9 until re-solved. Ties in the nett event to be resolved by a count back on the final round.

18-hole events played as near as possible to the plates. The best score of both the midweek and weekend rounds will be awarded the respective trophy. In the event of a tie, a playoff will take place at a time convenient to all parties, as approved by the LMC. If still tied a sudden death playoff will take place over holes 8 and 9 until resolved.

SINGLES KNOCKOUT COMPETITION

The event is knockout from the championship plates, off current handicaps over 18 holes. If you wish to qualify, advise the pro shop before teeing off. Please ensure you are available for all rounds.

PAIRS KNOCKOUT COMPETITION

Best 8 pairs in the 18-hole qualifying round are eligible to compete. If you wish to qualify, advise the pro shop before teeing off. Please ensure you are available for all rounds. There is both a midweek and weekend knockout. The qualifying round is played off full handicaps. Once the knockout commences, the lowest marker in each group becomes the scratch marker giving strokes to the other players as per the match index. If a member of the pair is unable to play (late or ill), the partner may play part of or the whole round alone. All ties in the competition will be decided by sudden death until a result is obtained. The event is knockout from the championship plates, off current handicaps over 18 holes.

Only the winners of monthly medals from October to September each year are eligible. The lowest score off handicap over 18 holes stroke play is to be deemed the winner of the medal of medals. Any ties for the medal will resolved by count back on the day.

GOLF COMPETITIONS AND HANDICAP APPLICATIONS

General Stroke Events

All singles, 2 ball, pairs, team and 4 ball stroke, par and stableford events are played off full Daily handicaps, unless stated otherwise.

Foursomes

Two players play as partners using one ball. The partners tee off alternate tees and thereafter play the ball in turns until holed. The pair's handicaps are combined and halved to establish their handicap for the event.

Ambrose

A team event usually played with 2, 3 or 4 players (3 player teams <u>are</u> allowed in 4 player events). All players tee off. The best tee shot is selected, and all players play from that point. The procedure of selecting the best position continues until the ball is holed.

Conditions of Play

- Play from the fairway (closely mown portion) players are to place their ball within one club length, either side of the selected ball, no nearer the hole.
- Play from the rough players are to place their ball within one club length, either side of the selected ball, no nearer the hole. All players must play from the rough.
- Play from bunkers/hazards players are to place their ball within one club length, either side of the selected ball, no nearer the hole. All players must play from the bunker/hazard.
- On the green players are to putt and mark, remembering that once the ball is holed, the hole is completed. Players place their ball within one putter head of the selected ball.
- Tee shot rule in a 4 person Ambrose event all players must have at least 3 of their tee shots used in the round, in a 3 person Ambrose event all players must have 4 of their tee shots used in the round. In a two ball Ambrose event a 6 tee shot rule applies. The players who teed off on each of the 18 holes must be shown on the scorecard (initials are satisfactory).
- Handicap applications 4 person Ambrose 1/8 of combined handicaps, 3 person Ambrose 1/6 of combined handicaps, 2 person Ambrose 1/4 of combined handicaps.
- If less than 4 players in a 4-person Ambrose team, the team still gets 4 putts when ON the green – the team can choose who has the extra putt(s).

Aggregate Pairs Event

Competitors in an aggregate pair's competition are fundamentally playing an individual stroke event, strictly in accordance with the relevant Rules of Golf. Neither is considered a partner of the other. Pairs are to be determined prior to tee

off and the starter informed.

2 Ball or Group Stroke, Stableford and Par Events

Pairs for the 2 Ball events are determined prior to tee off and the starter informed. Players one and two on the booking sheet make a pair as do players three and four. The better score of the partners is the score recorded for the hole. In the event of partners having the same score then the first one to finish or the best scratch score are recorded. **2 Ball best ball is not a team game advice is not allowed.**

4 Ball Stroke, Stableford and Par Events

Partners are determined prior to tee off and the starter informed. The better score of the partners is the score recorded for the hole. Four ball is same as 2 ball best ball, however you are a team and can give advice

Criteria for four ball events

- 1. Ensure you have a partner before entering in the competition
- 2. No swingers permitted disqualification

Swingers in 2 Ball & Pairs Events.

If a swinger is required in a 2 Ball or Pairs events a decision will be made between the players as to which player will be the swinger prior to tee off, and the starter informed.

BARNWELL PARK GOLF CLUB LTD BY-LAWS

Members are advised that the By-Laws of this club as set out hereunder must be observed. Failure to do so could result in action being taken against offenders.

- 1. All members and visitors will observe the Etiquette of Golf as referred to in Section One of the Rules of Golf.
- 2. Any member who has agreed to participate in an event in which that member is representing the Club and who fails to participate without having first notified the Event Manager, Club Captain, Vice-Captain or member of the relevant Match Committee (MC), then that member may at the discretion of the Board of Directors be guilty of conduct unbecoming of a member of the Club.
- 3. Any member who repeatedly places their name on the booking sheet and then fails to present themselves to play golf at the nominated time without having first notified the Starter, then that member may at the discretion of the Board of Directors be guilty of conduct unbecoming of a member of the Club.
- 4. Members are not permitted to participate in club competitions without a sand bucket. All members are required to carry a sand bucket at all times with the appropriate fill, as supplied, and use the fill for the filling of divots on tees and fairways.
- 5. All members shall repair lob marks on the greens.
- 6. When a group fails to maintain their position in the field and falls more than one (1) hole behind (& does not invite the following group to pass through either voluntarily or by request from the following players), EACH PLAYER in that group may, at the discretion of the Club Captain, relevant Vice-Captain or relevant MC, be PENALISED TWO (2) STROKES for failing to observe the rules of golf.
- 7. Complaints on any golfing matter are to be in writing and be handed to the Captain, relevant Vice-Captain or relevant MC immediately on completion of the round, or if not available, to the bar staff with instruction that they must provide the written complaint to a Committee member at the first opportunity. Complainants should advise the other party of their

intentions to report the matter to the MC.

8. All members shall comply with the following dress regulations. The following dress is not permitted on the golf course at any time: training or athletic shorts; denim shorts or jeans; singlets; thongs or football gear (i.e. shorts, jumpers or socks).

Ladies must not wear leotards, brief tops or brief shorts at any time. Whilst men cannot wear denim shorts, neat tidy shorts including denim are acceptable attire for ladies as long as they are not brief and not the 'blue jean' type of shorts. These rules will apply to all members and visitors.

- 9. Rake all bunkers carefully and evenly after playing from them. Leave the lie that you would want for yourself. Replace with rake fully into the bunker with the handle pointing away from the centre of the bunker. Try to push sand away from the edge.
- 10. The lowest marker in any group on the course is deemed responsible for the conduct and etiquette of the group. *This includes managing slow play.*
- 11. Should a player or marker be in doubt as to a rule of golf or a local rule applicable to a particular incident in the course of play, that player must immediately upon returning to the Clubhouse report the facts to the Captain, Vice-Captain or a member of the relevant Match Committee for a ruling. In stroke play if in doubt you can proceed under Rule 3-3 and play two balls and note scores for each ball and obtaining a ruling after the round. The card should not be signed until this ruling has been given.
- 12. It is the responsibility of the "proposer" and "seconder" immediately a nominee is elected to membership to see that such a new member is introduced to other members, is advised of all pertinent rules of the club and above all, is sufficiently advanced in the knowledge of the Rules of Golf to be competent to perform the duty of "marker" to a fellow competitor. Members should play with their nominee until the nominee is so equipped.
